Scratch Project

Topic: Scratch Programming – Movement, Background Change, Talking, and Broadcast

Objective: Create a small animated story or scene using Scratch that includes:

Sprite movement

Background changes

Talking using the "say" block

Broadcast to control sequence of events

Assignment Instructions:

Title: My Summer Adventure

Task:

Create a Scratch project where a character (sprite) goes on a summer adventure. Your project should follow these steps:

1. Choose Characters and Backgrounds

Add at least 2 sprites (e.g., a boy and a cat).

Add 3 different backgrounds (e.g., beach, park, home).

2. Add Movement

Make the main character move across the screen using the move or glide blocks.

3. Add Talking

Use the say block so your character can talk at each location. Example: "Hi! I'm going to the beach!"

4. Use Broadcast

Use broadcast and when I receive blocks to:

Change backgrounds.

Make the next sprite respond or appear.

5. Sequence Example:

Start at Home

Character says: "Let's go on an adventure!"

Broadcast: "Go to Park"

In Park (new background)

Background changes.

Character glides and meets a friend.

Both talk using say blocks.

Broadcast: "Go to Beach"

At Beach (final background)

Background changes.

Characters say: "What a fun day!"

Save the project as "My Story".

Save the file with name of the child as file name and share it in class id
