Fruit Fractions Activity

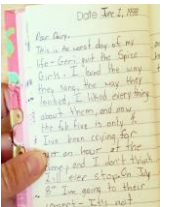
- *Use drawings or paper cut-outs of different fruits.

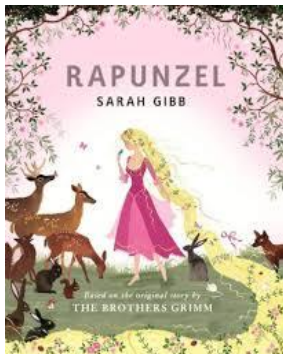
